Beguia, The Grenadines by Claire Metharam, Head of Product - Caribbean, Indian Ocean & Far East

I hadn't been to the Caribbean for probably 15 years so I was delighted to have the opportunity to reacquaint myself with the region earlier this year. I travelled to Bequia, a small island in the Grenadines. And I wasn't disappointed. Everyone kept saying, Oh, its like the Caribbean was 20 years ago. Not the Caribbean I knew

that long ago. Bequia is truly charming, a simple way of life with a truly Caribbean vibe. The Grenadines is well known for the yachting fraternity, and if I'm honest I'd probably think it wasn't "my scene" but I was truly surprised by how un-encroaching life on the waves is to the land lubber's enjoyment of the islands. The bays are full of yachts of all shapes and sizes, with 'convenience boats' offering laundry services, ice, espressos, you name it, bobbing in the blue.

My view of the bay was enjoyed from the recently renovated Bequia Plantation Hotel, a charming property to base yourself for a stay on the island, just a stone's throw from Port Elizabeth where you'll find a whole host of eateries and bars, one boasting the best lobster pizza on the island. Alas I didn't have the opportunity to sample the fayre, but it's on my hit list for a return visit!

Whilst in The Grenadines it would have been a crime not to have taken a boat trip through the islands. A 90 minute spin in a speedboat took us to Tobago Cays Marine Park (TCMP) which houses a series of globally significant habitats including coral reefs, sea turtle nesting sites and feeding areas, and small systems of mangroves. The marine portion of the park surrounds five uninhabited cays, the populated island of Mayreau, and three islets. The four-kilometer long Horseshoe Reef, the longest of the four main reef systems in the TCMP, encloses four of the cays (Petit Bateau, Petit Rameau, Baradal, and Jamesby) with the fifth cay (Petit Tabac) lying just outside the reef. Seriously, a day I will never forget.



The autumn will see a new address on Bequia's map. The Liming, a boutique 5-star property of just 9 villas set amongst the natural beauty of the island. Five-Star Luxury is a new concept in Bequia but the standard of resort promises something very special indeed. I, for one cannot wait for my return visit to master the art of doing nothing and of course, to try that pizza!



Belmond La Residencia and Deia itself can only be described as magical. My trip began on arrival into Palma where I was met at baggage claim and my case was taken to my luxury transfer. After perusing the "music menu" for my journey, I decided Flamenco Chill was the way to go whilst being driven through the beautiful Mallorcan hills.



One of the first things that struck me when arriving at La Residencia was how close and central it was to Deia, the entrance being on the main street along with the wonderful restaurants, shops and cafés, and the hotel itself, once in the grounds feels like you could be a mile away from the village. It has the perfect combination of serenity and calm at the hotel, and having the life and soul of the village right on your doorstep.

The hotel itself blends in beautifully with surrounding traditional Mallorcan architecture, and is actually somewhat of a Tardis considering how much they have to offer! After checking in I enjoyed a coffee on the terrace with Belmond's usual impeccable service, fantastic views and the hotels very own homemade truffles and biscuits (very tasty, I recommend the white chocolate and coconut balls!). The terrace of Café Miro is a hub of activity where passers-by pop in for drinks as well as hotel guests, it truly is the heart of the hotel and offers spectacular views

whilst dining as well. Café Miro use their own olive oil (also delicious), and the waiter's recommendations are definitely to be trusted, everything was fabulous. (cont'd...)

I decided to sample the delights of the spa on my first afternoon and opted for a back massage, heavenly, and just what I needed after being up since 2 am! And of course a spa afternoon wouldn' be complete without a swim and a visit to the sauna and outdoor Jacuzzi.

The hotel being set into the hillside ensures that every room has a view whether you're in a standard double or presidential suite. I can highly recommend the Executive Junior Suites with a plunge pool -

I've never had such a spectacular setting for breakfast or an afternoon dip. Having the option for breakfast in your room is also a great feature, allowing you to indulge in all the wonderful fruits, pastries and dishes like French toast with local honey, all on the privacy of your terrace.

Evenings at La Residencia are just as delightful as the days, as the sun sets, the Deia hills are bathed in orange light all whilst the hotels pianist plays Ravel's Bolero, and I'm enjoying a glass of Majorca's Mare Gin & Tonic. Antiques and works of art are found throughout this palatial building and give a real sense of occasion to dinner. Dinner was superb but we didn't expect to go paddling afterwards! The rising "Acqua Alta" tides had meant the water levels rose to the point we needed to buy ourselves wellington boots and wade back to L'Orologio – all good fun and the basis for some very amusing holiday snaps.
